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Advanced Communication Skills (2 day training course)

Open to Health and Social Care Professionals who are regularly involved in complex, difficult or challenging conversations with patients, families or colleagues and wishing to practice and enhance their communication skills in a safe and supported environment.

Overview

The training provides a structured evidence based and practical approach to advanced communication skills based on the Connected ACST course.

Over the 2 days participants are able to refresh and review their current communication skills practice and experience through the use of:

- Scenario based role play using expert actors and video feedback
- Interactive workshops
- Reflective practice discussions
- Experimental learning

Building confidence to deal more effectively with difficult, challenging and emotional conversations.

Overview

This 2 day Train the Trainer Facilitator course offers the opportunity to develop the, skills and understanding to deliver a 1 day Advance Care Planning (ACP) education day to staff in your organisation.

Our Session Includes

- The opportunity to attend the 1 day Advance Care Planning education day prior to the 2 day Train the Trainer course.
- Preparing facilitators to become Advance Care Planning champions, cascading learning, mentoring staff and promoting ACP within their organisation.
- Facilitators can attend annual ACP Facilitator/Champion forum meetings.
- You will be supported and mentored with your personal development in this role.

Syringe Driver Training

Overview

This 3 hour session gives Registered Nurses the chance to enhance their clinical skills, and refresh their knowledge around the subject of syringe drivers.

You will have the opportunity to learn about the theory behind syringe drivers and why we use them, the practical application of syringe drivers in clinical practice and end of life, and time dedicated to practicing how to set up a syringe driver so that you can feel more confident when using them in your practice.

- Commonly used medications
- Medication doses
- Converting oral to Continuous Subcutaneous Infusion
- Demonstration
- Practical
