

WALK TO REMEMBER

FAQ'S

+ What time do we need to arrive?

Registrations on the night start at 6pm at Ulverston Leisure Centre, LA12 9HT where we will have pre-walk entertainment. The walk commences at 8pm therefore you will find it is dark for the majority of the walk, we strongly advise that you have a headtorch with you on the evening.

+ Do we need to bring tickets?

There is no requirement to bring any paperwork/tickets with you on the evening, just head to the registration desks on arrival and our team of wonderful volunteers will be delighted to welcome you.

+ How long is the walk and how long will it take to complete?

The walk is approximately 10 miles long (just under) or 5 miles if you're doing the W2R half and will start at 8pm. Depending on the individual, finish times will differ. Staff and volunteers will be at Furness Academy until the last person finishes.

+ Will headwear be available to buy on the night? *

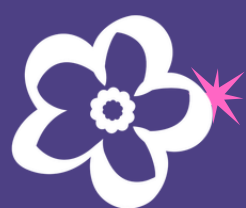
YES! No Walk to Remember is complete without the addition of Flashing Headwear and Festival Face Glitter! These will be available to purchase on the evening.

+ When can I collect my T-shirt?

To make it easier for you there will be two dates one in Ulverston and one in Barrow where you can collect yours and anyone else's t shirt prior to the event. This means that you are free to decorate your t shirt at home, and or add a picture of your loved one and come ready in your t shirt on the evening. If you cannot make either of the dates then you can still collect your t shirt when you register on the event field. T Shirts unfortunately cannot be collected on any other dates or times.

+ Can I drink alcohol?

Alcohol is **not** to be consumed during the event at any times. Anyone who is under the influence of alcohol will no longer be allowed to participate in the walk.

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+ Can I bring my dog?

Yes, we love to see your furry friends joining us at the event. All we ask is that your dog is kept on a lead at ALL times, and that you are a responsible dog owner with regards to waste both on the event field and on the walk itself. If you would like to bring your dog, we ask you to position yourself at the rear of the walk at the start as we do not want any accidents to happen should someone trip over, or stand on your dog. *Dogs are NOT permitted in the Furness Academy building at the finish of the walk.

+ Will there be food at the event field?

Yes, we will be joined by the absolutely delicious "Love Pizza" (who sold out last year!) and a new addition of Cloud Nine Kitchen, a Coffee and drinks van as well as sweet treats all are local food vendors so please do support them by coming and having your tea with us. There will be designated picnic benches for you to sit on whilst enjoying your food and watching the live entertainment.

+ Where are the toilets?

We will have toilets available at the following places Ulverston Leisure Centre, Our Lady's School Dalton, Abbey Road Barrow, and at the finish at Furness Academy.

+ Can I park my car at Ulverston Leisure Centre? *

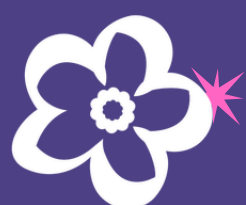
Unfortunately for participant safety no vehicles are permitted into the leisure centre whilst the event is taking place. Alternatively, you could use the swimming baths car park on Priory Road. Parking and vehicles around the area of Our Lady's school again is strictly not permitted due to participant safety, if you are being collected or have people supporting you on the evening we please ask that they use Charnleys Home and Garden car park next door to the school.

+ Will there be fireworks?

This year we have taken the decision to not have fireworks on the event field. As a hospice we have a duty of care to respect not only the surrounding residents and animals but participants and their four-legged friends. But don't worry we have some exciting new elements to signal the start of W2R 2027.
